FROM OUR AMAZING PRESIDENT

Dear Boys & Girls Club Family and Friends,

When we say “Great Futures Start Here” we mean it — because at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Carroll County we see the immense impact we have on our community every day. As we reflect on the past year and look forward to the future, we are filled with gratitude, pride, and hope for what lies ahead — thanks to you.

This year, we continued our growth by increasing our bandwidth to five locations, allowing us to serve 900 youth across Carroll County — a 24% increase from the previous year. Our flagship locations in Westminster and Hampstead continue to thrive, and our community impact sites at Northwest, Mt. Airy, and Sykesville Middle Schools helped us welcome even more Club members. With your continued support, 2025 will be the year we reach over 1,000 youth across Carroll County.

In April we launched our North Carroll Clubhouse, serving 113 different teen members from Manchester Valley, North Carroll, and Shiloh. Additionally, our innovative Kahlert Leadership Academy saw 93 teens graduate — ensuring that our kids are workforce & future ready! Every middle and high school in the county had representation at the Academy.

Last April we received 1.4 million dollars in Federal funding that will help us renovate an additional 4,000 square feet in the form of a Youth Center at North Carroll. This additional expansion will set the foundation to serve elementary students from the Hampstead area in the future.



We take pride in “growing our own” leaders. We currently have 13 Club alumni on our staff, working in various roles to give back to the organization that shaped them. Their passion and dedication will be instrumental as we launch our Alumni Association, creating a lasting network of support for future generations.

Keystone Club: Teens Championing Change

We recently launched the Keystone Club, a teen-led group focused on service, advocacy, and youth engagement. Members take the lead in planning service projects, organizing teen nights, and sharing their perspectives to shape Club programs. Keystone gives teens a platform to make a difference, build skills, and play an active role in Club decision-making.





Our North Carroll Clubhouse is Open!

The North Carroll Clubhouse has officially opened at the former North Carroll High School, providing a welcoming space for youth from North Carroll Middle, Shiloh Middle, and Manchester Valley High School. It also serves as the home of the Kahler Leadership Academy, where teens can build leadership and workforce skills, connect with mentors, and explore new opportunities. The Clubhouse features dedicated learning spaces, a recreation area, rooms for mentorship and leadership programming, and a STEM Center with a greenhouse, giving members a place to learn, grow, and engage in hands-on experiences.



New Wheels, New Adventures!

Thanks to an anonymous donor, the Club now has a 12-passenger van, making transportation easier for members. The van provides rides between Clubhouses and provides opportunities for field trips, career exploration, and leadership events, giving youth greater access to new experiences beyond the Club.

Fishing Club is about more than just catching fish, it's about casting confidence and building resilience. Teens head to a local lake, learning both traditional and fly-fishing techniques, mastering the patience and skill required to reel in a big catch. Whether perfecting a cast, tying a fly, or celebrating a first catch, each trip challenges them to stay focused, problem-solve, and support one another. Fishing Club gives teens a chance to

disconnect from stress, connect with nature, and gain the confidence to tackle new challenges—both on and off the water. It's a Teen favorite!



The Next Big Thing: Entrepreneur Club

Entrepreneur Club is all about big ideas, bold creativity, and bringing dreams to life! This small group gives kids the chance to think like business owners, developing their own product from start to finish. They brainstorm ideas, create a business plan, and design their products—learning the skills real entrepreneurs use every day. Members will put their business to the test, selling their creations at the Spring and Summer Market at the Ag Center and showcasing their work at the Winter Market at Carroll Community College. Whether it's crafting, designing, or innovating, this club is all about turning ideas into reality and showing kids that their creativity has value.

Beyond Reality: VR Club

Step into a whole new dimension—where imagination knows no limits! Virtual Reality transports kids into incredible 3D worlds, letting them explore, create, and experience the impossible. Whether soaring through space, exploring the deep sea, or stepping into a world they designed themselves, our members are fully immersed in experiences that feel real. The excitement is contagious—from the moment they put on the headset, they're completely captivated. In VR Club, learning and play merge into one, making every experience unforgettable!



Positive Action: Developing Champions Through Positive Choices

Funded by a grant from the Maryland Community Health Resource Commission, Positive Action is a countywide program that helps kids build confidence, self-control, and positive decision-making skills. By understanding how thoughts, actions, and feelings are connected, youth develop a positive self-concept and take ownership of their actions. This year, we've seen incredible growth—kids are practicing self-management by taking responsibility for their decisions, showing honesty and integrity in their daily interactions, and developing social skills like respect, teamwork, and communication. With a focus on continuous self-improvement, Positive Action is shaping champions for life.

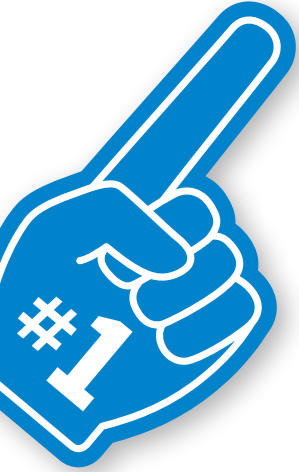

Community Champions



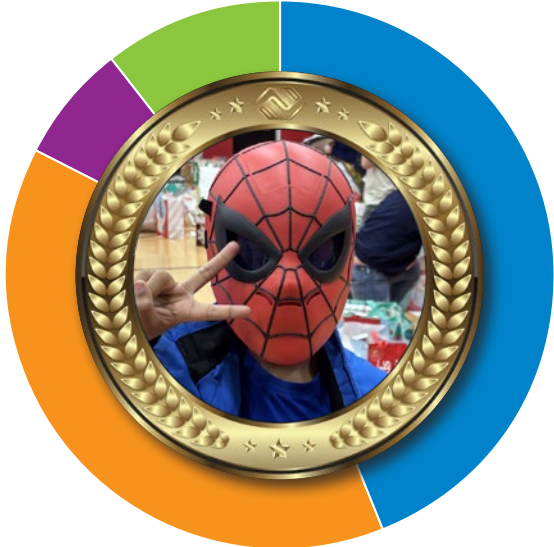

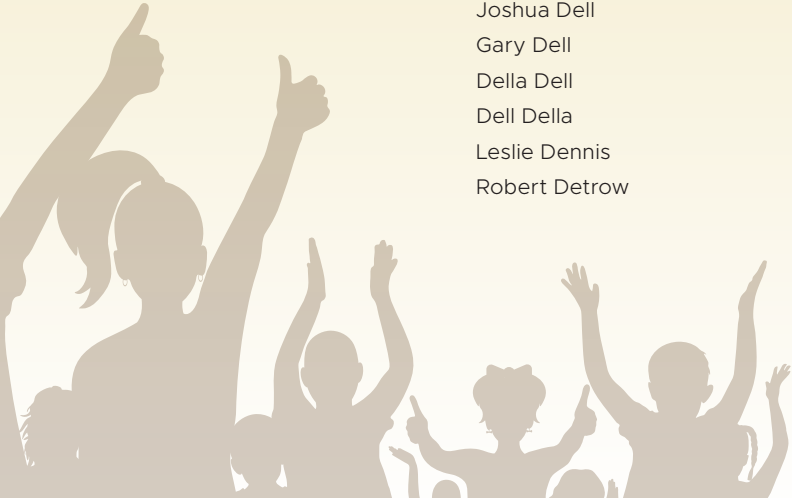

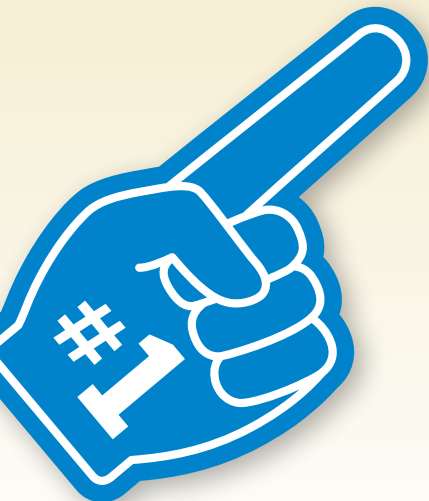
