Your video should be submitted to dleazer@bgccarrollcounty.org by April 15

The winner of this scholarship will be announced at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Carroll County Youth of the Year Ceremony.

- Your video should be no shorter than one minute and no longer than five minutes.
- The recipient of this scholarship must be a graduating high school senior with plans to pursue post-high school education at a trade school, community college, or four-year college.
- While you can get creative with your presentation, you (the applicant) should be the focus of the presentation and the primary speaker.
- You should submit your video as a link or file via email to dleazer@bgccarrollcounty.org, or you should turn in a flash drive with the video by April 15 to Debbie Leazer at the Westminster Boys & Girls Club.

Addressing the Application Prompt – Helpful hints:

If given the opportunity, what kind of charity organization would you create?

To answer this question, make short video explaining the cause your charity would support and why you would choose that cause.

Some questions you might consider addressing in your video:

- What personal experiences do you have with the cause or issue on which your charity would focus? Where did this idea come from?
- What specific groups and populations would the charity support? In what ways would your charity support them?
- Would your charity address an issue in the local (Carroll County) community?
- Who might you enlist to represent, support, and/or help you run this charity? (Examples: members of the local community, celebrities, public figures, etc.)
- Where and how would you seek funding for the charity?
- What skills and experiences do you currently have that would help you create, promote, and maintain the charity organization?
- What skills or experiences might you need to cultivate in order to successfully start your charity organization?

The listed questions are simply recommendations for ways to approach this prompt. You do not need to answer them all, but you should aim to clearly and concretely address the bolded prompt above.

In general, the video should give viewers a clear idea of a current issue that matters to you, why it matters to you, and how you would work to address it through the creation of a charity organization if given the chance.
